Dear Mr. Dunn:

The Maloney Street bridge, which is currently posted at 33T/58T/73T, was recently inspected by our bridge consultant as part of our normal inspection schedule. Following the inspection, a load analysis was performed and it has been recommended by our consultant that this bridge be posted as follows:

Gross Vehicle Weight (in tons)		
19T (38,000 lbs.)	25T (50,000 lbs.)	42T (84,000 lbs.)
Single truck or bus.	Truck and trailer or tractor and semi-trailer.	Tractor, semi-trailer and trailer.

This item will be on the agenda at the September 26, 2019 Road Commission for Oakland County Board meeting for review and/or approval. At this time these load reductions do not prohibit the usage of common vehicles (school buses, fire trucks, delivery trucks). However, garbage trucks should monitor their loads to be sure they are within the legal limits. We will continue to monitor the condition of this structure and attempt to identify future funding in order to repair or replace this structure and remove these load reductions. For your convenience, a map is enclosed along with a list of various vehicle classifications and their corresponding weights.
